Dr. Terry Carter

Since October of 2022, Dr. Terry Carter has served as the Interim Senior Pastor at Trinity Baptist Church. He has been married to his wife, Kathy, for 50 years and credits her as a strong supporter behind the ministry work they have been able to do during that time period, including pastoring on the mission field in Wiesbaden, Germany for seven years.

Dr. Carter has served as the interim pastor in 27 churches in Arkansas, Texas, and Europe. In addition to his role at Trinity Baptist Church, he also currently serves as Vaught Professor of Christian Ministries and Director Horne Center Christian Ministries at Ouachita Baptist University (OBU) in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

Dr. Carter has more than three decades of experience in Christian higher education, preparing students to become pastors. As part of his academic career, Dr. Carter has authored



or co-authored numerous books and articles including *Preaching God's Word*, which is used as a textbook at OBU, and Telling God's Story: The Biblical Narrative from Beginning to End.

Dr. Carter earned his bachelor of arts degree from Howard Payne University and his master's degree and PhD from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. He has been married to his wife for 50 years, and they have one daughter, Tilly, who is married to Brent and three grandchildren, Carter, Nora and Lawson who live in Charlotte, North Carolina.

MARRIAGE MINISTRY

Re|engage is about relationships. Our goal is to help you grow in your relationship with your spouse, with other couples, and with God. God has designed marriage to be a supportive, loving, life-giving relationship that mirrors His own unconditional love for us. Re|engage will help you better understand

that design and learn how to apply it to your own marriage.

Every week begins in a large group setting, where you will hear stories from other couples whose marriages have been transformed. Re|engage leaders will also share practical steps you can take to improve your own relationship. After meeting as a large group, you will break off into smaller groups, with each group led by a facilitator couple. Together, you and your small group will work through the 16-lesson curriculum and learn how to effectively communicate, resolve conflict, and grow closer to your spouse.

RECOVERY MINISTRY

We all experience brokenness in life. We all have struggles to overcome. Whether big or small,



these destructive thoughts and habits hold us back from the life we want—and the life God calls us to live. God loves you, wants to heal you, and has a plan for you. Through re:generation, thousands of people have found freedom from their struggles and experienced new life in Christ.

Addictions and sin struggles steal from you; they keep you from having the life you really want. Re:generation is a biblically-based program offering healing, recovery, and freedom from any type of struggle. It is a 12-step discipleship ministry based on the principles of healing and life transformation found in the Bible. You will begin each weekly meeting gathered with others in the program to hear stories of life change or teaching. Then you will split off into small groups of men or women to discuss what you are learning through the curriculum.
