2. What did your parents teach you about what was important in life? Money? Good job? Reputation? Faith?
3. Are they still married (if deceased, did they stay married until passing)?
4. What was especially difficult for you about life as a child and teenager?
5. How important was faith/God/church to your family while growing up?
6. If you have been married previous to your current marriage, what was the primary cause of the end of that relationship?
7. When did you come to faith and how did that happen? Or, if you would question your belief, what are your doubts about faith? (You can both have faith and still have doubts).
8. How would you describe God? How would you describe your current relationship with God?
9. What was your life like as an adult prior to marrying? (Partying?, Multiple intimate relationships?, etc.).
10. Have you read every book of the Bible?
11. What, in your opinion is the biggest problem in your marriage?
